We now live in a most challenging time. It's as if the powers of darkness have collaborated with evil human rulers in high places with the intention of destroying mankind. What can we do?

For our struggle is not against flesh and blood, but against the rulers, against the powers, against the world rulers of this darkness, against the spiritual forces of evil in the heavens. Ephesians 6:12

We need to "stand in Christ" not only during our time of intercession but also throughout the week.

Our weekly gatherings look like this.

- * We begin with a meal and table talk. People discuss whatever they like.
- * Generally this morphs into some kind of spiritually focused discussion but not always.
- * It can be family issues or world events or other.

- * We do pray. That might happen while still at the table but more so during our time waiting on the Lord.

If this sounds unrehearsed and unplanned, it is. We do however try to have three segments: 1) A mealtime together, 2) Discussion, 3) Waiting on the Lord with song and prayer.
